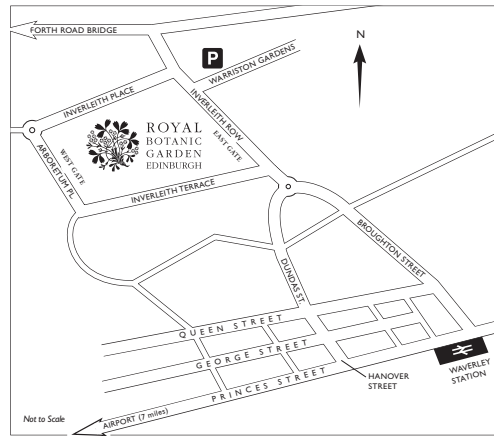
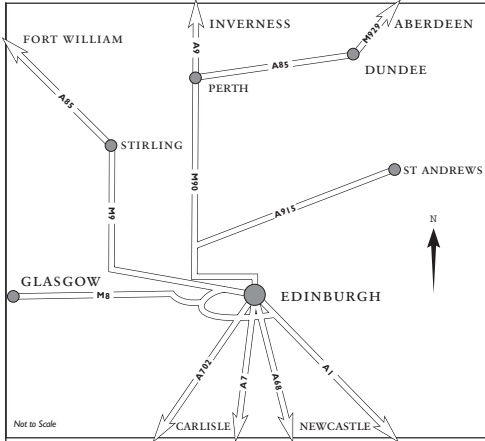




Location Information
