



Application details

Candidates applying for a role at the Museum need to complete the online application form and provide sufficient evidence to demonstrate how their knowledge skills and experience meets the detailed criteria outlined in the job description.

It is advisable that candidates prepare their answers to the questions in a Word document first, which can be transferred into the online application form.

Please note there is a 4,000 character limit on the amount of text that can be included in the online application form.

Additional documents can also be provided to support application forms.

As part of your online application, you will need to:

1. Make sure you complete each section fully.
2. Provide specific examples from achievements, knowledge and experience or skills and competencies that demonstrate how you meet the requirements of the role.
3. Describe what attracted you to the role.

If there is anything else you wish to tell us, that you have not had the opportunity of doing elsewhere in the application form, then you can email this separately.

These supporting documents should be emailed to the named contact (or to our general enquiries email provided on the website).

Individual covering letters and CVs will not be considered, but can be used to support completed online application forms.
