



Lord Green of Hurstpierpoint

The Lord Green of Hurstpierpoint began his career as a civil servant with the Ministry of Overseas Development. In 1977, he joined McKinsey & Co Inc, management consultants, before joining The Hong Kong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited in 1982. He fulfilled a variety of roles at HSBC, culminating in becoming Group Chief Executive in 2003 and Group Chairman in 2006.

Lord Green was Chairman of the British Bankers' Association from 2006 to 2010, and was made a life peer on 16 November 2010 as Baron Green of Hurstpierpoint. He was Minister of State for Trade and Investment from 2011 to 2013. Lord Green was also a former trustee of The British Museum.

Lord Green is Chairman of Asia House and President of the Institute of Export and International Trade.

Stephen Green has written four books – *“Serving God? Serving Mammon?”* (1996); *“Good Value, Choosing a Better Life in Business”* (2009); *“Reluctant Meister - How Germany's Past is Shaping its European Future”* (2014); and *“The European Identity – Historical and Cultural Realities We Cannot Deny”* (2015).
